Kia ora whānau,

As of yesterday, we have released a minor, non-breaking version update to our [ACC45 Claim Submission API](#).

What has changed?

Following feedback, we have prioritised resolving high priority pain points with the current service, and now support the following functionality:

- Enabled the ability to capture 'Another Gender' as a value on a patient's claim, in addition to Male, Female or Unknown options – now in alignment with the Stats NZ standard
- Allow the additional diagnosis side location 'Bilateral' to be used for an Injury diagnosis (in addition to Left and Right)
- Extend the character limit of Patient First Name to 40 characters (currently 20)
- Extend the character limit of Patient Middle Name to 40 characters (currently 20)
- Extend the character limit of Patient Surname to 50 characters (currently 25)
- Improved user friendly error message when the SNOMED to READ diagnosis code translation tool is unavailable
