Kia ora,

On the evening of Tuesday 26th September we are making a back-end change to the Query Claims API to move it off a legacy database. While making this change, an enhancement will be applied to the paging on one of the Query-Claim operations.

What's changed

Paging has been enhanced on the "get claim status by NHI/DOB" query (GET claims/status/filter), to be consistent with other APIs. It will now accept page and page size query parameters. If those parameters aren't provided it will default to page 1 and a page size of 100, which we will look to reduce to 25 per page in approximately 6 months' time to provide performance improvements and complete the final alignment with the other APIs.

What this means for you?

- If you are already using pagination on GET claims/status/filter queries
 - You don't need to do anything
- If you're not using pagination on GET claims/status/filter queries
 - We recommend that you implement this in the next six months to ensure when we reduce the default page size to 25 your users are still able to access the full five-year claim history
